ISU Format Events:

SENIOR – Ladies, Men

Short Program Duration: 2 minutes and 50 seconds maximum, but may be less. The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2014, Rule 611 and respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: Duration: Men: 4 minutes and 30 seconds, +/- 10 seconds. Ladies: 4 minutes, +/- 10 seconds. In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2014, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communications.

JUNIOR – Ladies, Men

Short Program Duration: 2 minutes and 50 seconds maximum, but may be less. The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2014, Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3, for season 2016/17 and the respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: Duration: Men: 4 minutes, +/- 10 seconds. Ladies: 3 minutes and 30 seconds, +/- 10 seconds. In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2014, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communications.

ADVANCED NOVICE – Girls, Boys

Competition will be held in accordance with ISU Communication No. 1947.

Short Program Duration: Boys, Girls - 2 minutes and 30 seconds maximum, but it may be less. The required elements to be skated are listed in ISU Communication No. 1947.

Free Skating Duration: Boys: 3 minutes and 30 seconds, +/- 10 seconds. Girls: 3 minutes, +/- 10 seconds.

Open Format International Events:

OPEN JUNIOR * (19 Years of age and older) – One Age Category

This event is open to all skaters that have a Junior Level of skating, but do not fulfill the ISU Age Requirements therefore, they have reached the age of 19 before July 1st of this year. There is no age restriction up. All current level descriptions apply.

INTERMEDIATE* – Age Categories Apply

Short Program Duration: 2 min **MAXIMUM**

- a) Single or Double Axel
- b) Jump Combo – 1/2, 2/2, 2/3 or 1/3
- c) Double or Triple jump preceded by steps (Different from a) and b))
- d) Spin in One Position (May have Fly Entry, but no change of foot. Min. 5 revs.)
- e) Spin Combo (only 1 change of foot and minimum 1 change of position. Min 5 revs. each foot. **No Fly Entry Allowed**)
- f) Choreo Sequence

Free Program Duration: 2:30 min, +/- 10 sec.

Maximum 6 Jump Elements: **All singles, Doubles and Triples Allowed**, One Axel Type Must be included, Maximum 2 repetitions of the same jump and must be in a combo or a sequence. Only 3 Combos Allowed, from which one may be a three jump combo.

Maximum 2 Spins: -1 spin combination; with or without change of foot - Min 8 revs

-1 spin with only 1 position; no change of foot - Min 5 revs

Both spins may start with a flying entry. Spins must be of a different character

IJS Will be used, Levels of Difficulty will apply without restrictions and all 5 Components will count

BASIC NOVICE B* Girls, Boys

Age requirements: Basic Novice B skater is who was **born: 1.7.2000 - 30.6.2002** Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2014, ISU Communication 1947 and all respective ISU Communications.

Only Free Skating Duration: 3 min, +/- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE A* Girls, Boys

Age requirements: Basic Novice A skater is who was **born: 1.7.2002 – 30.6.2005** Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2014, ISU Communication 1947 and all respective ISU Communications.

Only Free Skating Duration: 2 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

Levels for spins and sequences apply without restrictions (All Levels Possible)

JUVENILE* - Age Categories Apply

Free Program Duration: 2:15 min, +/- 10 sec.

Maximum 5 Jump Elements: **All Singles, Doubles and 2 Axel allowed - Maximum.** One Axel Type Must be included, Maximum 2 repetitions of the same jump and must be in a combo or a sequence. Only 2 Combos Allowed, from which one may be a three jump combo.

Maximum 2 Spins: -1 spin combination; with or without change of foot - Min 8 revs

-1 spin with only 1 position; no change of foot - Min 5 revs

Both spins may start with a flying entry. Spins must be of a different character

One Choreographic Sequence (Fixed Value) or Step Sequence (Levels Apply)

CUBS – European Format & Age*- Girls, Boys

Age requirements: Cubs skater is who was **born: 1.7.2005 – 30.6.2007**

Only Free Skating Duration: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

A well balanced CUBS Free Skating Program must contain:

- a) Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted. Triple jumps are not permitted. Any single or double jump (including DoubleAxel) can not be executed more than twice in total.
- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.
- c) There must be a maximum of one to choose from: Choreographic Sequence with a fixed Base Value or a Step Sequence where levels apply.

Level explanation: For Cubs in all elements which, are subject to Levels, here **ALL features will be counted.** The **5 Program Components** are also judged here **without restrictions.**

CHICKS – European Format & Age * - Girls, Boys

Age requirements: Chicks skater is who was **born: 1.7.2007 – and younger**

Only Free Skating Duration: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

A well balanced CHICKS Free Skating Program must contain:

- a) Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted. Triple jumps are not permitted. Any single or double jump (including Double Axel) cannot be executed more than twice in total.
- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.
- c) There must be a maximum of one to choose from: Choreographic Sequence with a fixed Base Value or a Step Sequence where levels apply.

Level explanation: For Cubs in all elements which, are subject to Levels, here **ALL features will be counted.** The **5 Program Components** are also judged here **without restrictions.**

PRE-JUVENILE* - Age Categories Apply

Free Program Duration: 2 min, +/- 10 sec.

Maximum 5 Jump Elements: All Singles, Doubles - **Except 2 Axel.** One Axel Type Must be included, Maximum 2 repetitions of the same jump and must be in a combo or a sequence. Only 2 Combos Allowed, from which one may be a three jump combo of 2 doubles and one single jump. Only the repetitions of singles is not restricted.

Maximum 2 Spins: -1 spin combination; with or without change of foot - Min 6 revs
-1 spin with only 1 position; no change of foot - Min 4 revs
Both spins may start with a flying entry. Spins must be of a different character.

Maximum 5 Jump Elements: All Singles including Axel, and 2 Doubles to choose from: Salchow, Toe or Loop are Allowed. One Axel/Waltz Type Jump Must be included, Maximum 2 repetitions of the same jump and must be in a combo or a sequence. Only 2 Combos Allowed, from which one may be a three jump combo of 2 doubles and one single jump. Only the repetitions of singles is not restricted.

Maximum 2 Spins: -Spins may change feet and/or position - Spins may start with a flying entry

- Min 3 revs - Spins must be of a different character. **ISU LEVELS WILL APPLY***

One Choreographic Sequence (Fixed Value) or Step Sequence (Levels Apply)

PRE-PRELIMINARY* - *Age Categories Apply*

Free Program Duration: 1:40 min - Maximum

Maximum 5 Jump Elements: All Singles including Axel are Allowed. Maximum 2 repetitions of Axel and must be in a combo or a sequence. Only 2 Combos Allowed, from which one may be a three jump combo of single jumps is allowed. The repetitions of singles is not restricted.

Maximum 2 Spins: -Spins may change feet and/or position - Spins may start with a flying entry

- Min 3 revs - Spins must be of a different character.

One Choreographic Sequence (Fixed Value)

NO TEST/BASIC* - *Age Categories Apply*

Free Program Duration: 1:40 min - Maximum

Maximum 5 Jump Elements: All Singles except Axel are Allowed. Only 2 Combos Allowed, from which one may be a three jump combo of single jumps is allowed. The repetitions of singles is not restricted.

Maximum 2 Spins: -Spins may change feet and/or position - Spins may start with a flying entry

- Min 3 revs - Spins must be of a different character.

Stag and Split jump must have 90° angle minimum to count.

Maximum 2 Spins: 2 Foot Spin and Upright Spin. For the 2 Foot Spin we accept the creativity and it is highly encouraged. Levels of difficulty are applied for features as follows:

- Different position (Variation) plus 1 Extra (Use of Head, Hands and/or Arms), no restriction on repetitions of these features to gain levels of difficulty according to table.
- Difficult Entry -Turning on Both Directions (3 Revs each side minimum)
- 8 Revolutions without change of position/variation.

1 Choreographic Sequence with fixed value.

DEBUTANT 2*- Age Categories Apply

Free Program Duration: 1:30 min - Maximum

Maximum of 5 Elements to choose from: -2 foot turning (Maximum 4 Revs) – Spiral (on Edge) – Mazurca Jump - Buny Hop jump – 1 foot deep (shoot the duck) – Spread eagle – Ina Bauer.

All elements have a fixed value of 1 point.

Two repetitions maximum per element are permitted within the 5 element limit, after these any repeated element has a 2 point deduction from total. After the 4th revolution of the 2 foot turning there will be a penalization of 5 points from the total (this is a beginner intended element, not a 2 foot spin). Spiral position counts only on edges and once the leg is above hip level. 1 Foot Deep counts only when leg is parallel to the ice.

All 5 components will be applied, and encouraged to be explored. No half Jumps, singles or any other jumps or spins are permitted, except what is described as element for this level.

DEBUTANT 1* - Age Categories Apply

Free Program Duration: 1:30 min - Maximum

Maximum of 5 Elements to choose from: -Pivot (Minimum 1 Rev) – One Foot Glide – Lunge – 2 Foot Jump – 2 Foot Deep – Scullings/Swizzles (Sequence of 3).

All elements have a fixed value of 1 point.

Two repetitions maximum per element are permitted within the 5 element limit, after these any repeated element has a 2 point deduction from total. 2 Foot Deep counts only when legs are parallel to the ice.

All 5 components will be applied and encouraged to be explored. No half Jumps, singles or any other jumps, spins or elements from the next level are permitted, except what is described as elements for this beginner level.

AGE CATEGORIES – Age fulfilled during 2016

5 Years and younger = A

6-9 Years = B

10-14 Years = C

15 Years and above = D

ADULTS – AGE CATEGORIES AS BELOW

ISU ADULT*

Adult ISU Age Classes will be combined in two as follows:

Class B – 28-54 Years fulfilled on 2016 – (Class I, II & 1st half III)

Class A – 55-79 years fulfilled on 2016 – (Class V, IV & 2nd half III)

ELITE MASTER* - Ladies, Men

Duration The maximum time is 3 min. 10 sec., but may be less.

- a. A maximum of seven (7) jump elements, one of which must be an Axel type jump. Single, double and triple jumps are permitted. Any jump can be repeated only once and this repetition must be done either in a jump combination or in a jump sequence. There may be up to three jump combinations or jump sequences in the Free Program. One jump combination could consist of up to three (3) listed jumps, the other two up to two (2) listed jumps.
- b. A maximum of three (3) spins of a different abbreviation, one of which must be a spin combination with a change of foot and one must be a flying spin. The spins must have a required minimum number of revolutions: five (5) for the flying spin with no change of foot after landing, five (5) for the spin with only one position and no change of foot and five (5) for the spin combination with no change of foot and eight (4 + 4) for the spin combination with change of foot or spin in one position with a change of foot.
- c. A maximum of one step sequence (Levels Apply)

MASTER* - Ladies, Men

Duration The maximum time is 3 min. 10 sec., but may be less.

The technical requirements are the same as those for the category "Masters Elite Free Single Skating".

GOLD* - Ladies, Men

Duration The maximum time is 2 min 40 sec., but may be less

a. A maximum of six (6) jump elements, consisting of any single or double jumps (including a single Axel) except double Flip, double Lutz and double Axel. No triple jumps are permitted. Any jump can be repeated only once and this repetition must be done either in a jump combination or in a jump sequence. There may be up to three jump combinations or jump sequences in the Free Program.

b. A maximum of three (3) spins of a different abbreviation, one of which must be a spin combination with a change of foot and one must be a flying spin. The spins must have a required minimum number of revolutions: four (4) for the flying spin with no change of foot after landing, four (4) for the spin with only one position and no change of foot and four (4) for the spin combination with no change of foot and eight (4 + 4) for the spin combination with change of foot or spin in one position with a change of foot.

c. A maximum of one step sequence (Levels Apply)

SILVER* - Ladies, Men

Duration The maximum time is 2 min 10 sec., but may be less

a. A maximum of five (5) jump elements. The single Axel and all other single jumps are permitted. Any jump can be repeated only once and this repetition must be done either in a jump combination or in a jump sequence. A jump combination may consist of the same or another single jump. There may be up to three jump combinations or jump sequences in the Free Program. One jump combination could consist of up to three (3) listed jumps, the other two up to two (2) listed jumps.

b. A maximum of three (3) spins of different abbreviations, one of which must be a spin combination. The spins must have a required minimum number of revolutions: three (3) for the flying spin with no change of foot after landing, three (3) for the spin with only one position and no change of foot and four (4) for the spin combination with no change of foot and eight (4 + 4) for the spin combination with change of foot or spin in one position with a change of foot.

c. A maximum of one choreographic step sequence (ChSq – Fixed Value), covering at least half of the ice surface.

Duration The maximum time is 1 min. 50 sec., but may be less.

- A maximum of four (4) jump elements. Only single jumps are permitted, no Axel type jump. Any jump can be repeated only once and this repetition must be done either in a jump combination or in a jump sequence. A jump combination may consist of the same or another single jump. There may be up to three jump combinations or jump sequences in the Free Program. One jump combination could consist of up to three (3) listed jumps, the other two up to two (2) listed jumps.
- A maximum of two (2) spins of a different abbreviation; The spins must have a required minimum number of revolutions: three (3) for the spin with only one position and no change of foot and four (4) for the spin combination with no change of foot and six (3 + 3) for the spin combination with change of foot. Flying spins are not permitted.
- A maximum of one choreographic step sequence (ChSq), covering at least half of the ice surface.

MISCELANEOUS

Liability: In accordance with the ISU Regulations, Rule 119 the Organizer accept no liability for the damage or injuries which any of participants, judges, officials or others may suffer. It is highly encouraged for every individual taking part on the event to have their own insurance to cover any expense, which is the sole responsibility of the participants. The hosts will provide basic first aid for the event, but the rest must be planned by the participants in any case of emergency.

Results: The results will be calculated in accordance with ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules 2014 Single and Pair Skating 2014 – Rules 352 and 353 (ISU Judging System) plus the adaptations of the levels used in the event by FEMEPASHIDI.

Awards: Skaters placed first to third will be awarded medals and diplomas, all the others diplomas.
